
Adjusting Filter Display Order

You can change the order in which items are displayed in a Filter list by adjusting the lookup table in Titan.

If a filter's default order is not the one you'd prefer to use, you can adjust the order in which items are displayed. Let's take a look at how that's done within your Titan Workstation.


Step 1

Access your Titan Workstation and enter the Admin Menu.




Step 2


Filters are controlled by lookup tables which are hosted within the Data Schemas area of Titan. Under Data Schemas, select the group that houses the Lookup that you wish to edit – you may have multiple groups of Data Schemas within your Workstation.



After locating the appropriate group within the Data Schemas menu, select Lookups.




Under Lookups, you can find all your lookup tables. You can re-arrange filtered list items (known in Titan as Attributes) within an Attribute Group (they are listed Alphabetically and Numerically as default).



You can also create a new Attribute Group within a Lookup Table in order to apply a custom sort order without altering the sitewide default for this particular Lookup.

Step 3

You can either add Attributes/items in order or click and drag them once they've been added to the Attribute Group filter table. Make sure to save your changes when complete.





Step 4

Once you've updated or created your Attribute Group, go to the page that features the filter you want to edit, either by searching for it or navigating to it within the Content section of your Titan Workstation.


Step 5

Locate the Data List Block on your targeted page and scroll down to the Filter Your Results section of the block.



Step 6

Double click to open your Lookup. Your new Attribute Group can be found under the Display Configuration section, by selecting it within the Subset dropdown. Make sure to save your changes and Publish.



Note: When adjusting the Lookup Table, do NOT edit the Attribute Selection section. This section is used to apply default filters to a lookup table on a page.
