Changing the Display Order of Carousel Images

You can edit the order in which images appear within a carousel by adjusting the Display Order.

Note: These instructions assume your carousel (known as a Series Image in Titan) is already set up with images – you do not need to re-upload images or recreate the carousel to adjust the order in which these images appear.



Step 1

Before editing the carousel within your Titan Workstation, identify the file names for your images and the order you intend to set them. You can do this by inspecting the image on your live site or referring to your image files in Titan.





Step 2

Locate your Series Image file pile within your Titan Workstation. If you're unsure which Block this is you can double click in order to open and verify.




Step 3

Select the image you would like to set the order of and then enter the Properties Menu using the button within the top middle Titan menu.



Step 4

Within the Properties Menu, scroll down to Sorting and update the Display Order to the number you would like the individual image to appear within the carousel – starting with 1. We recommend utilizing Display Order increments of 5 or 10 so that should a new image need to be added within a series, you do not need to re-update each image individually.



Step 5

Since the default Display Order for all items is 1, you will need to update each image within the carousel in sequence in order to get them to display in the desired order. In this example, since we set our first image to 1, we are setting the second image to 5 and so on. In the future, should we need to add an additional image between the first and second image, we can set the Display Order to a number between 1 and 5, rather than update each image's Display Order individually.
